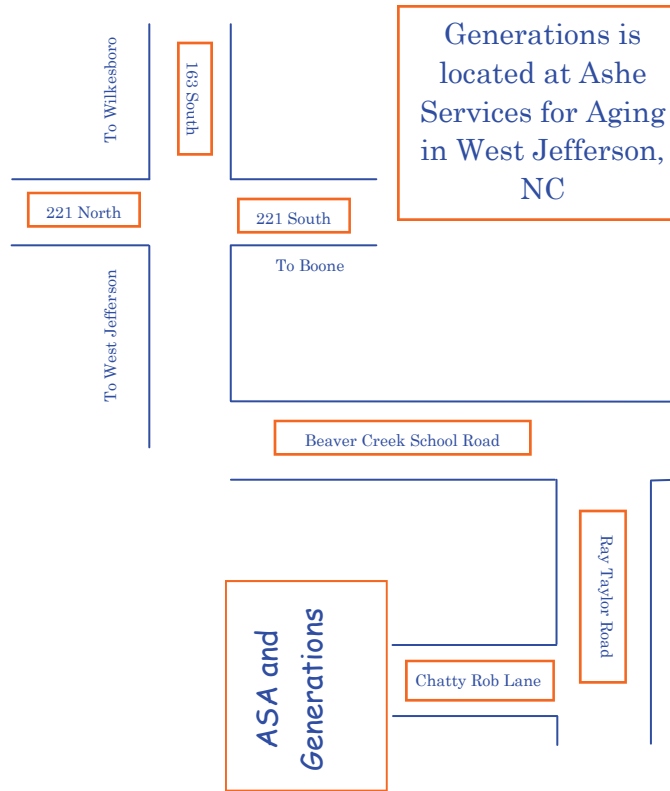

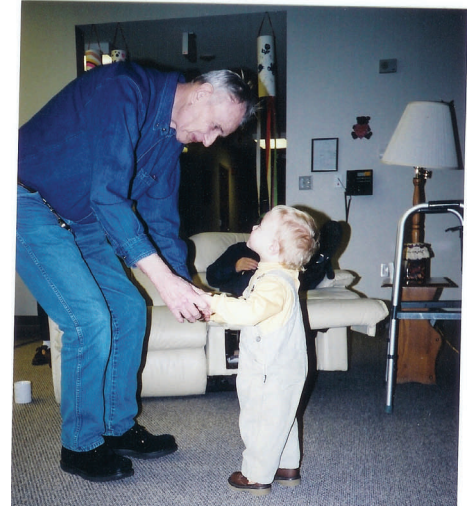

About Generations Developmental Day Center



Generations is a developmental day center that is licensed by the NC Division of Child Development and certified to provide developmental day services to children with special needs as well as typically developing children and their families.

The center is co-located with Ashe Services for Aging in West Jefferson and offers intergenerational experiences for children through informal visits and joint activities with adult day center participants and informal and planned interactions with adults visiting the senior center.

Children ages birth through 5 years are served in a fully inclusive setting.
